



Preparation for Bible Quizzing and Sample Questions

1. PRAY
2. Enlist coaches – one per team.
3. Select team members as soon as possible.
4. Have an objective standard to use in choosing your team(s)
 - a. Progress in their handbooks, but accuracy in their recitation
 - b. Knowledge and accuracy in giving answers during competitions: Large Group time and Quiz practices
 - c. Proper attitudes shown toward other teammates and those in authority
5. Establish a practice schedule.
6. Use quizzing periodically beginning in early fall during Large Group time to prepare and excite the clubbers for the Bible Quiz. Begin with easy questions.
 - a. Have the game teams compete against each other
 - b. Have clubs compete against clubs
 - c. Have your church compete with clubs of the same age from other churches
7. Involve the parents
 - a. Provide each quiz family with a copy of the Rulebook and Guidelines
 - b. Ask one or both parents to be at the Bible Quiz practices whenever possible.
 - c. Encourage parents to review with their quizzer regularly and consistently at home.
 - d. Encourage parents to attend the Bible Quiz.
8. Thoroughly review the materials and design practice questions.
9. Practice the format of the quiz in addition to the quiz material.
10. Work with team members to be sure they really understand the material they have memorized.
